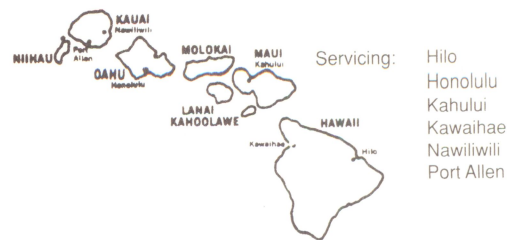

SUBJECT: Pilot Order Times for Nawiliwili and Barbers Point Harbors

In order to comply with daylight only vessel movement restrictions at Nawiliwili and Barbers Point harbors, HPA dispatchers will only be accepting requests for pilots in compliance with these time restrictions:

- **ARRIVALS:** Requested pilot on board time must be no earlier than sunrise, and no later than 30 minutes before sunset.
- **DEPARTURES:** Requested pilot on board time must no earlier than 30 minutes before sunrise, and no later than 30 minutes before sunset.

These time restrictions are necessary since there is always a time lag between the pilot boarding time and last line (for departing vessels) and between pilot boarding time and the time the vessel actually enters the harbor (for arriving vessels). We have discussed this with DOT Harbors Division, and were pleased to learn that these time restrictions will be incorporated into the programming logic for the proposed Hawaii.PortCall.com web scheduling system.
